We don't need more 'luxury' flats

Lewisham is in a housing crisis, and developments like the one proposed on the old site of Convoys Wharf in Deptford are the sorts of projects that are fueling it. This development doesn't even meet the targets of Lewisham Council for affordable housing or social rent, let alone the actual needs of the local community. In fact, the proposed development is so bad that even Lewisham Council wouldn't approve it- it had to be pushed through by Boris Johnson himself in 2014.

This is not a 'development' in any meaningful sense- it is an investment that lines the pockets of investors at the expense of everyone else. This gigantic plot of land, set in the heart of Evelyn ward- a borough that has been hit hard by years of gentrification, over-crowding, homelessness, and dodgy landlords- provided a huge opportunity to build the genuinely affordable housing and public space that we actually need. Instead, once again, the needs of capital have been put above the needs of everyone else. Once again, we have private car parks instead of public green space. Once again, we have the promise of empty flats bought and sold as commodities instead of real homes.

Voice 4 Deptford-a local campaigning group-is calling a public assembly for anyone in the local area who wants to be part of a fight to force the developers to listen to the needs of local residents and imagine ways that the land could be used to make our lives better. HISTORICAL WOMEN OF LEWISHAM: KATH DUNCAN

Kath Duncan was born in Fife in 1889. She was a Communist, LGBTQ, a powerful orator and an energetic radical activist. In the 1930s Kath was living in Ommany Road New Cross. She campaigned with Greenwich dock workers against the arms trade which led to her arrest in Deptford Broadway - one of many times she was arrested. She also organised against slum landlords, attended the Battle of Cable Street and raised money for ambulances during Spanish Civil War. When she died, thousands lined the streets of South London in tribute.
