The plan was to make the building a home for refugees from all over the world. Unfortunately, the Metropolitan Police evicted the protest from the privately owned house worth millions of pounds. The Met on the wrong side of history as usual!

London Makhnovists are named after the Ukranian anarchist revolutionary Nestor Makhno. They are planning a summer of action so keep an eye out.
